2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN – CAUTION - Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Use with adequate ventilation. Eye protection and gloves are suggested when handling undiluted product. Wash thoroughly after handling. Contents may be under pressure. Use caution when opening. This liquid fertilizer solution is derived from Calcium Carbonate and Nitric Acid.

This product is a clear, brown liquid with no apparent odor. Primary routes of entry are eye contact and skin contact.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

If in eyes:	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing:	Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If inhaled:	Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If swallowed:	Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to do so. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IF MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

Ventilate area. Contain spill, absorb liquid with clay or other absorbent material. Sweep up material and place in container for possible land application according to label use or for proper disposal. Check local and provincial regulations for proper disposal.

CAUTION: Keep spills and cleaning runoff out of municipal sewers and open bodies of water.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING: Open the container carefully. Contents may be under pressure. Eye protection and gloves are suggested when handling undiluted product. Use with adequate local ventilation. Wear chemical impervious gloves, footwear, coveralls or impervious apron. Protect eyes with goggles or a face shield when handling undiluted product. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove clothing immediately if product gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in original container only. Store in a dry place above 40°F / 4.4 °C. Avoid freezing. If product freezes, allow it to warm and then mix thoroughly before use. Do not use food or drink containers for mixing or storage. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

ENGINEERING CONTROLS: Not normally required. If odor is too strong use local ventilation.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION: Not normally required, if vapors are too strong wear a NIOSH/MSHA approved respirator for organic vapor with dust, mist and fume filters.

EYE PROTECTION: Chemical goggles or shielded safety glasses.

SKIN PROTECTION: Wear protective clothing: long-sleeved shirts and pants, shoes with socks. Wear rubber or chemical-resistant gloves.
