## GENERAL INFORMATION

**N-Pact™ SRN is a foliar fertilizer that contains Triazone, a patented slow release nitrogen compound.** N-Pact™ SRN may be applied either undiluted or diluted (with water) for aerial or ground application. Use sufficient carrier to adequately cover area.

**N-Pact™ SRN** should be well mixed with water, water/fertilizer solutions, or pesticide solutions before application. Application should be made in early morning or late evening. Some foliar burning could result if applied during hot, dry daytime conditions. Phytotoxic symptoms may occasionally occur on very sensitive crops at certain stages. For additional information on rates, timing of application and hybrids or crops susceptible to phytotoxicity, consult your local farm advisor.

## PRECAUTIONS

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Use with adequate ventilation. Eye protection and gloves are suggested when handling undiluted product. Wash thoroughly after handling. Contains ammonia. Contents may be under pressure. Use caution when opening.

**Phytotoxicity:** Plant and leaf injury may occur on some crops when certain weather and growing conditions are present. User assumes all risks of use and handling.

The prevention of nutrient deficiencies in crop is preferable to correcting them after symptoms appear, although this can often be done by prompt soil and/or foliar application. Applications are recommended when fast correction is necessary.

It is recommended that soil and/or plant tissue samples be analyzed to determine nutrient levels prior to using this product. This product is to be used where deficiencies, based on soil/tissue analysis, have been identified.

## FIRST AID

**If in eyes:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Continue flushing for at least 15 minutes and call a physician if irritation persists.

**If on skin:** Flush affected skin with water. Remove contaminated clothing. Launder clothing before reuse.

**If inhaled:** Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician if indicated.

**If swallowed:** Drink plenty of water if conscious. Call a physician or poison control center immediately for advice on inducing vomiting. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. A poorly sealed container may adversely affect product quality. Store in original container only, preferable in a locked area. Store in a cool, dry place, Avoid freezing. If product freezes, allow it to warm and then mix thoroughly before use. Do not use food or drink containers for mixing or storage.

**PRODUCT DISPOSAL:** If product cannot be used as intended, disposal should comply with provincial regulations. Avoid contaminating water by disposal of equipment washwaters or other product wastes.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly, adding rinsate to mixing tank. Then offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill.

## COMPATIBILITY

**NORTRACE® N-Pact™ SRN** can be applied alone or with other compatible spray materials. Proposed mixtures should be evaluated in a jar test before full scale use. Fertilizer based mixtures that also contain pesticides should be sprayed as soon as possible.

## MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

**NORTRACE® N-Pact™ SRN** mixes easily with water, as follows:

1. Fill tank half-full with water and start agitation.

2. Add recommended amount of N-Pact™ SRN, compatible micronutrients, any flowable materials, any emulsifiable materials, any soluble powders and/or water soluble fertilizers. (All soluble powders and/or water soluble fertilizers should be pre-dispersed in water before adding the spray tank).
3. Fill tank to desired volume and continue to agitate thoroughly prior to spray application.

#### **APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS**

**NORTRACE®** N-Pact™ SRN is recommended for application to various crops. For general application, apply 8.5 to 17 liters of this product per hectare and repeat the application at one-three week intervals as necessary until two weeks before harvest. It is recommended that soil and/or plant tissue samples be analyzed to determine actual rates of application prior to using this product. This product is to be used where deficiencies, based on soil/tissue analysis, have been identified.

The prevention of nutrient deficiencies in crop is preferable to correcting them after symptoms appear, although this can often be done by application.
