This granular inoculant contains living organisms and requires a relatively high moisture content compared to granular pesticides. To optimize flow (especially under humid conditions) it is suggested to only fill large compartments to no more than 50 percent capacity.

Directions for use:

To be used only in Western Region. Drill granular inoculant directly below the seed in furrow. Use drill attachments or applicators to meter the material accurately (similar to applying small amounts of granular pesticides). Use the equipment manufacturer's directions to calibrate before planting.

Granular inoculant should be applied at 28.5 g/304 linear row meter (5.3 kg/ha for 17.8 cm row width) (1 oz/ 1000 linear row feet or 4.7 lbs/acre for a 7 inch row width) – use the table below to calculate application rates for common row widths.

The Spherical granules have a bulk density of 592 - 641 kg/m³ (37-40 lbs /cu. ft).

STORAGE/PRECAUTIONS

- Store granular inoculant in a cool 1-20°C (34-70°F) dry place and away from pesticides and bulk fertilizers.
- Store bags flat, keeping off of floor (ie. Pallet) to avoid direct contact with cold damp surfaces.
- Use before expiration date.
- Apply granular inoculant directly to the furrow. The product must not be applied at a depth that is less than the planting depth of the seed.
- Do not mix granular inoculant with granular pesticides or fertilizers during planting.
- Remove any unused granules from the hopper box at the end of each days planting. Do not allow granules to sit in hopper overnight.
- Environmental conditions may affect flowability of the product. Regularly check metering system to ensure proper flow.
