Black Label Zn is a blend of three important nutrients using a patented manufacturing process. **Black Label Zn** (6-20-0 + 0.77% Zn) is a Phosphorous, Nitrogen and Zinc source and uses technology designed to protect applied phosphorous from reacting and “tying-up” with calcium, iron and aluminum in all soil types.

- Added zinc for improved phosphorous assimilation

Application Information

Black Label Zn is registered on most crops and offers you flexibility to fit your operation. **Black Label Zn** is tank mixable with a broad range of pesticides* and may also be applied through drip and centre pivot irrigation equipment. Multiple applications can be made through the season if necessary.

- Broadcast Applications – Apply 2 to 6L/Acre in a minimum of 5 gallons of water
- Soil Applications – Apply 6 to 12L/Acre

Mixing Instructions

Black Label Zn mixes easily with water, as follows:

1. Partially fill tank with water and start agitation.
2. Add pesticides or other nutrients. **Black Label Zn** is compatible with micronutrients if used at a minimum of 8 parts to 1 part micronutrient.
3. Add **Black Label Zn** last to circulating tank mix.

**Not compatible with Calcium fertilizers and salts of heavy metals. Always do a jar test when mixing with other products. Always read and follow all label directions.*
