### **UP-Cyde Use Rates for Fruit**

<i>Fruit</i>	<i>Pests</i>	<i>Application</i>
Apples	Bud Moth, Leafrollers, Plum Curculio, Codling Moth	Apply 400 mL/ha when insects or damage first appear.
	Spotted Tentiform Leafminer	Apply 400 mL/ha at peak emergence of the first & later generations of adults.
	Apple Maggot	Apply 400 mL/ha when adults appear in late June or early July; repeat sprays every 10 days but not more than 3 times during the season.
	Apple Leaf-curling Midge, White Apple Leafhopper	Apply 400 mL/ha when insects or damage first appear.
	Winter Moth	Apply 280 mL/ha when insects or damage first appear.

## UP-Cyde Use Rates for Fruit

<i>Fruit</i>	<i>Pests</i>	<i>Application</i>
Pears	Pear Psylla (Eastern Canada)	Apply 280 mL/ha when pest first appears.
	Pear Psylla (British Columbia)	Apply 200 mL/ha when overwintering adult densities are highest.
	Post Bloom Pear Psylla, Nymphs & Adults	Apply 400 mL/ha when pest first appears.
Grapes	Grape Leafhopper	Apply 240 mL/ha when pest first appears.
	Grape Berry Moth	Apply 240 mL/ha shortly before bloom & immediately after bloom. Apply additional sprays as insects of damage appear.
Strawberries	Strawberry Weevil (Clipper)	Apply 280 mL/ha when buds are first visible & repeat when first buds show white.
	Tarnished Plant Bug	Apply 400 mL/ha at first bloom and repeat 7 to 10 days after bloom.
	Meadow Spittle Bug	Apply 280 mL/ha when first buds show white.
Peaches & Nectarines	Oriental Fruit Moth, Tarnished Plant Bug, Oak Plant Bug	Apply 280 mL/ha with 550 L of water per hectare. Do not apply more than twice per season.
Plums	Plum Curculio	Apply 400 mL/ha when insects or damage first appear.
